- 101** Mionetto, Prosecco DOCG, Italy
Aromas of golden apples, honey, and white peach; well-balanced acidity provides a fresh and lively mouthfeel with a clean dry finish.
- 102** Innocent Bystander, Sparkling Pink Moscato, Australia
Currant, marshmallow and mandarin peel on the nose; flavors of strawberry candy, violets and honeycomb with well-balanced sweetness
- 103** Proscotto, “Italian Method” Sparkling White
Honeysuckle, ripe golden apple and white tropical fruits; predominant juicy flavors on the front palate give way to a fresh, zesty finish
- 104** Marqués De Cáceras, Cava, Rioja, Spain
Bouquet of citrus fruits with notes of brioche; round in the mouth with a refreshing, balanced structure
- 105** Gruet, Blanc de Noirs, New Mexico
Elegant and focused, with creamy vanilla and apple aromas and rich yet crisp flavors of baked pear and cinnamon bread
- 106** Grand Courtage, Sparkling Rosé, Nuits-Saint-Georges, Burgundy, France
Bright aromas and flavors of fresh strawberry and raspberry with notes of lilac and violets; on the palate, wild berries and pomegranate alongside soft floral note
- 107** Monte Ory, Rosé of Garnacha, Navarra, Spain
Bright and intense strawberry, very fruity, highly aromatic persistence with intense scents of red and citrus fruit and lingering aromas of white flowers
- 108** LVE, Rosé of Grenache / Syrah / Cinsault, Côtes de Provence, France
Aromatic with delicate notes of peach blossom, raspberry and apricot; on the palate, crisp notes of fresh strawberry and white nectarine lead to an elegant, mineral finish

- 201** Selbach, Riesling, Mosel, Germany
Bright acidity balanced with just the right amount of sweetness; carries a touch of petrol on the nose with stone fruit, honeysuckle, and mineral notes on the palate
- 202** Le Pianure, Pinot Grigio, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy
Aromas of apple, pear and juicy lemon; the palate is clean and vibrant offering a long fruit and mineral-driven finish
- 203** Eyrie, Pinot Gris, Dundee Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon
Driving notes of stone fruit and fresh fennel; the racy natural acidity is complemented by a texture that is round while still being dry and light

- 204** Taonga, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand
Classic citrus and tropical fruit aromas; the flavors of stone fruit, fig, gooseberry and grapefruit are accented by hints of fresh-cut grass, and are complemented by crisp acidity and a juicy, refreshing finish
- 205** Domaine Fournier Père et Fils, Sauvignon Blanc, Loire Valley, France
Citrus and passion fruit aromas, with hints of Fleur de Sel, chive and flint; the palate is zesty with a nice salivating acidity
- 206** Broadside, Unoaked Chardonnay, Central Coast, California
Poached pear, yellow apple and a hint of ginger on the fragrant nose; energetic on the palate, offering juicy orchard fruit, orange zest and vanilla flavors and a late suggestion of anise and delicate smoke
- 207** Amici, Olema, Chardonnay, Sonoma County, California
Classic aromas of apples, honey, stone fruit, ripe lemon, and cinnamon stick; rich and viscous palate of golden apple, bartlet pear and savory lemon zest and thyme
- 208** ZD, Reserve Chardonnay, Carneros, California
Aromas of guava, pineapple, and lime zest are complemented by hints of orange blossom and vanilla; the palate is rich and full of citrus notes mingled with crème brûlée, and subtle, warm oak
- 209** Tenuta Olim Bauda, Gavi di Gavi, Piedmont, Italy
Lemon and mineral notes on the nose with soft but persistent citrus on the palate is underpinned by an overwhelming freshness and intensity.
- 210** Marco Porello, Roero Arneis, Piedmont, Italy
Intensely floral and fruity on the nose leading to a juicy white fruit and fresh citrus fruit profile, with notes of almonds, beeswax, and flint
- 211** Chateau de Lisennes, White Bordeaux, France
Aromatic nose of tropical fruits, grapefruits and a hint of lemon; a subtle and fresh front palate gives way to a full and silky mid palate with elegant fruity notes and great length

- 301** Anthony & Dominic, Pinot Noir, North Coast, California
The flavor profile is fruit driven with berry and spice accents, a medium body, soft tannins and a jammy finish with notes of tobacco
- 302** Battle Creek Cellars, Unconditional, Pinot Noir, Oregon
Aromatics of red plum and autumn leaves are accented by subtle notes of lavender and boysenberry; flavors of bing cherry and raspberry, finishing with soft, tannins with a hint of pomegranate

- 303** Blue Jay by Walt, Pinot Noir, Rockpile, Sonoma, California
Aromas of wild blueberry, clove, caramel, and forest floor; the palate is plush and layered, with roasted stem inclusion adding breadth and savory notes; finish has deep flavors of sassafras root and black cherry
- 304** Bouchard Aîné & Fils, Bourgogne Pinot Noir, France
Wildflowers and red fruit on the nose, cherry, raspberry, and currant; palate is mild and terroir-driven, with earthy notes and lingering red fruits
- 305** Twomey by Silver Oak, Pinot Noir, Anderson Valley, California
Flavors of black cherry, blackberry, cola, spice and darker, loamy earth tones, accenting traditional notes of strawberry, raspberry and light cherry
- 306** Gen 5, Cabernet Sauvignon, Lodi, California
Well-structured with straightforward fruit flavors; dry, concentrated and appealing without overt oak influence; ripe cherry and blackberry notes fill the aroma while equally vivid fruit flavors coat the palate
- 307** Feudo Arancio, Cabernet Sauvignon DOC, Italy
Opens with aromas of cassis and star anise; the palate offers blackberry, vanilla and white pepper alongside smooth tannins
- 308** BonAnno, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California
Aromas of cedar, tobacco, and cocoa followed by a mix of currant, vanilla and fresh blackberry notes; the palate is loaded with fresh dark fruits, plum, currants and hints of cinnamon and vanilla.
- 309** Obsidian Ridge, Cabernet Sauvignon, Red Hills, Lake County, California
Blackberry jam, a touch of herb, spice, and coffee; full-bodied, expanding mid-palate with a dense core of black fruit, black cherries, and cacao beans; the finish lingers with a perfume of dried raspberries and rose water
- 310** Mt. Veeder, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California
Intense dark fruit aromas of ripe black cherry, black currant and plum interlaced with complex notes of sweet herbs, clove, vanilla, dark chocolate, and toasty oak
- 311** Caymus, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California
Layered, lush aromas and flavors, including cocoa, cassis and ripe dark berries, with a fruit-forward, jammy palate, finishing with hot cocoa, black cherry, and chocolate cake
- 312** Steele, Cabernet Franc, Lake County, California
Aromas of red cherry, raspberry, plum, and licorice; flavors are of red fruit, raspberry, and plum with smooth acidity, followed by soft tannins
- 313** Carletto, Montepulciano, d'Abruzzo, Italy
Aromas and flavors of stewed forest berries, ripe plum, biscuit with honey butter, red apples, and nutmeg with a satiny, vibrant, palate displaying notes of pomegranate, black tea, and sweet tobacco with light oak flavor

- 314** Canoe Ridge, The Expedition, Merlot, Horse Heaven Hills, Washington
Intense aromatics of fresh, ripe raspberry and blueberry; on the palate, crushed ripe berries, vanilla and leather linger with silky tannins
- 315** Salcheto, Chianti DOCG, Tuscany, Italy
Red berries, rose and crushed herb aromas mingle with scents of dark spice and a whiff of leather; raspberry, strawberry compote and star anise set against bright acidity
- 316** Santa Julia, Organic Malbec, Argentina
Red fruit and baking spices on the nose; medium-bodied palate has cherries, plums, and blackberries, with notes of vanilla, chocolate, and tobacco
- 317** Honoro Vera, Bodegas Morca, Garnacha, Catalayud, Spain
Bright aromas and flavors of red currant, cherry, and raspberry with a touch of toasted oak, spice and silky tannins
- 318** Tridente, Tempranillo, Castilla y Leon, Spain
Aromas of toasty oak, graphite, balsamic, incense, and black fruits; flavors of chocolate, licorice, black fruits, violet and tobacco.
- 319** Poggio al Tufo, Rompicollo, Sangiovese / Cabernet Sauvignon, Toscana
Aromatics of blackberry, bacon and ink, followed by dark berry, black pepper and spice notes; palate driven by red fruit and spice with a mineral filled aftertaste
- 320** Jérôme Gradassi, Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Côtes Du Rhône, France
Aromas of ripe black and blue fruits, along with hints of licorice and woodsmoke; palate-coating cassis and bitter cherry flavors with subtle floral and spice nuances
- 321** Marietta Cellars "OVR" Zinfandel / Petit Sirah / Syrah, California
Driving aromas and front palate notes of blackberries and black cherries, with secondary notes of wild mint, dusty earth and a hint of mocha
- 322** Lady of the Mandrake, Cab Sauv / Merlot, Paso Robles, California
Rich aromatic bouquet of black cherry, cassis, and sandalwood; the palate is rich with notes of blackberry, plum, cigar box, and marzipan; finishes with a hint of cocoa powder and clove
- 323** Capo Creek, Open Mic, Grenache / Syrah / Mourvedre, Sonoma County
Raspberry, red currant, and violets on the nose; palate boasts darker fruits with complex notes of herbs, olive, tea, cola and white pepper
- 324** Leviathan, Syrah / Cabernet Sauvignon / Merlot / Cabernet Franc, California
Rich and dark fruit-driven with mocha, chocolate, plums and terracotta; full body, round, juicy tannins and a solid, finish with lingering notes of cedar and black fruits
